
#### **Home Prices Still on the Rise**

#### **Median List Price | YoY**












#### **Rental Market: Millions of Adults Moved Back Home**

Annual change in number of adults living in a parent's or grandparent's home




### **Impact of Unemployment on Housing**

### **Unemployed in California, Mostly Renters**


Housing payments owed by newly unemployed homeowners and renters in each industry
